Tuesday	49

- Which is the best estimate for the total number of tomatoes that Carla has set out this week?
 - (A) 150 tomatoes
 - (B) 170 tomatoes
 - (C) 190 tomatoes
 - (D) 200 tomatoes

- The total number of tomatoes that Carla has displayed this month is 4 times the number she set out on Wednesday and Thursday combined. How many tomatoes has she displayed this month?
 - (A) 480 tomatoes
 - (B) 372 tomatoes
 - (C) 362 tomatoes
 - (D) 93 tomatoes

- Coal City has a population of 24,902 people. Iron City has a population of 24,859 people. Use the symbols $>$ or $<$ to write a comparison of the two populations.

- Ted has 40 pigs in each pig pen on his farm. He has 4 pens. How many pigs does Ted have in all of the pens?

- Jorge went to the store with \$200. He bought a sweatshirt for \$22 and shoes for \$27. How much money did he have left after his purchases? Explain.

- What is the value of the 4 in 24,659?
